

Are you receiving prescription medication to treat a workplace injury?

Starting September 3, 2013, the Workers' Compensation Board of Nova Scotia (WCB NS) is making changes to the **PayDirect** program for brand name medications. The WCB requires that generic medications be used when they are available. If there is a medical reason why you need a brand-name medication, your doctor must submit an Exemption Request Form and include an explanation. If you are currently taking brand-name medications for a work related injury and have concerns about this change, please talk to your doctor.
